## **Upcoming public meeting on the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Power Generating Sites: 2021***

The [Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission](#) (CNSC) will hold a public meeting in November 2022 where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Power Generating Sites: 2021* (NPGS ROR). The facilities and activities covered by the NPGS ROR are located in the traditional and treaty territories of many Indigenous Nations and communities. **This revised notice is to announce the exact date for this presentation and the location of the public meeting.**

CNSC staff will provide an overview of the CNSC's regulatory efforts related to licensed nuclear power generating sites and their onsite waste management facilities during the 2021 calendar year. Staff will also discuss the CNSC's regulatory oversight of refurbishment projects, including site-specific updates on units currently undergoing refurbishment activities.
