



Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a one-day public hearing to consider New Brunswick Power Nuclear (NB Power Nuclear)'s application to extend for a period of one year its operating licence for the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station (NGS), located on the Lepreau Peninsula in New Brunswick. During this hearing to consider the renewal of the licence for a one-year period, NB Power Nuclear will provide an update on its refurbishment activities and CNSC staff will also present its annual safety assessment (2009 NPP Report) for the Point Lepreau NGS.

Time: as set by the agenda published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcasted live on the Internet via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

The current Point Lepreau NGS operating licence expires on June 30, 2011. NB Power Nuclear is requesting a one-year extension of its existing operating licence in order to continue focusing on refurbishment activities that are scheduled to continue beyond the current licence end date. The licence would contain the same terms and conditions as specified in the current licence.

The public is invited to comment, in writing, on NB Power Nuclear's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by December 20, 2010 directly on-line at <http://www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/commission/intervention/index.cfm> or at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.

Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. Please submit your personal information on a separate page if you wish to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public upon request to the Secretariat.

NB Power Nuclear's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations to be considered at the hearing will be available after November 19, 2010. These documents are not available on-line and
